We are very excited to announce the completion of Phase One of our three-phase redevelopment project! The Rain Garden and MUGA are developments are finished and open!

So, what's next?

We are now in the final stages of planning for Phase 2, an extension to the existing site including:

- An overall renovation of the site
- A new shop for The Good Place pantry
- Addition of smaller meeting spaces
- A catering-standard kitchen
- An improved façade



These improvements will allow us to offer more flexible spaces for community projects and activities. On completion, we will move into the final phase,3, the community garden.

## STAMFORD HILL ESTATE

We're delighted to announce that we are partnering with **Southern Housing** to pilot The Good Place project at Stamford Hill Estate Community Centre.

From Thursday 3rd September, The Good Place project will relocate to Stamford Hill Estate Community Centre.

This move gives us the space to return to our original shop model while we prepare for the redevelopment of The Boiler House, which will include the creation of a new pantry shop.

We'll also have access to a dedicated meeting space, enabling us to expand the support services we offer to the community.

## WRAP AROUND SERVICES AT THE GOOD PLACE PANTRY



Do you need support?

**Family Action's** Social Prescribing team provide a drop in service on the 1st Thursday of the month during the Pantry hours 2-4pm. Their service offers tailored support to individuals & families, helping them improve their wellbeing by connecting them with local community activities, advice, and specialist services. Designed to support people at every stage of life, the service provides a holistic approach to addressing social, emotional, and practical needs.

FamilyLine is a free service available to support adult family members on all aspects of family life. Open Monday to Friday: 9am – 7pm. The helpline will be covered by **SHOUT** text crisis line outside these hours, including weekends and bank holidays.
